

This week in Reception, we have been very busy with lots of Autumnal activities. First, we made our Purple Poppies in preparation for our 'Evening of Remembrance' to commemorate the fallen animals. In addition, we have been learning all about the changes that take place during Autumn. We made some leaf crowns with the fallen leaves outside our classroom. We read 'The Leaf Thief' who needed our help to capture the thief! We designed and set up a trap in the outdoor learning area - putting an orange in there to entice the thief inside. In order to make sure the birds have enough food, we made some vegan fat balls and have had lots of feathered visitors outside our classroom including our resident squirrel. In our writing and mark making, we have been drawing the Character, setting and an adventure idea from the story. Reporting Absence

Reception Class 2024

If your child will be 4 years old before 1st September 2024, you must apply for a Primary School place online through the Tameside Council website: www.tameside.gov.uk



The application facility is open from early November 2023 and the closing date for Primary School applications is 15th January 2024.

ANY application received after 15th January 2024 will be dealt with as a 'LATE' application and considered after those received on time.

Is Your Child Eligible for Free School Meals / Pupil Premium?

Did you know that School can claim additional funds from central Government for **every** child in **any** year group whose Parent/Carer is receiving one of the welfare benefits listed below?

- Universal Credit, provided they have an annual net earned income not exceeding £7,400(£616.67 per month)
- Income Support
- Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Support under Part 6 of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- The guarantee element of Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit, provided they are not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190, as assessed by HMRC
- Working Tax Credit run-on paid 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit

The additional funds are put towards valuable support like extra tuition, additional teaching and pupil welfare. If eligible, your child will also have the option of enjoying a Free School Meal every day.

So if you are in receipt of any of the benefits listed above we would be very grateful if you could complete the online form at www.cloudforedu.org.uk/ofsm/sims-tameside and check your eligibility.
