
Therefore, we request that no dogs are brought into the school grounds at any time, either on a lead or carried.



If your child is absent from school please ensure you report their absence to the school office as soon as possible on the **first day and each day thereafter detailing the reason for their absence**.


There is a facility to report pupil absence via our switchboard 0161 330 5248.
