This half term we will focus on:

Science

This half term we will learn about 'Materials and their properties'. We will be:

- Exploring objects and naming the different materials they are made from.
- Learning about absorbent and waterproof materials
- Learning about transparent and opaque materials.

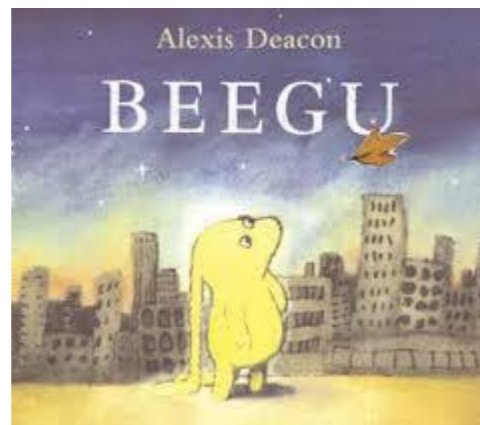
English

This half term we will be writing our own 'alien' narrative based on the story "Beegu" by Alexis Deacon.

We will also be developing our writing skills by producing, posters, captions, letters, speech bubbles and a report.

We will focus on:

- Application of taught phonics when writing.
- Forming letters correctly.
- Leaving spaces between words.
- Using capital letters, full stops, exclamation marks and question marks.
- Orally rehearsing sentences and reading sentences out loud.
- Using adjectives to add detail.
- Using 'and' to join clauses.
- Using ed to show the past tense.



What can you do at home?

Read lots of stories with your child.

Listen to your child read as much as possible. Remember to sign the reading diaries to earn a raffle ticket!

Do one homework task each week and upload to dojo.

RE

In RE we will be explore the question: What makes some places sacred?

We will talk: about:

- The meaning of the words 'sacred' and 'holy'
- What things and places are special to pupils and their families, and why
- Notice some similarities and differences between places of worship and how they are used.
- Explore the meanings of signs, symbols, artefacts and actions and how they help in worship

Through our PSHE learning we will be learning about:

- Hygiene

- Fairness and managing online information.

Geography:

Our geography unit is called:

Through this unit we will:

- Name and locate the four countries on a map of the UK.
- Identify the country we live in.
- Identify the four compass directions.
- Use the compass directions to describe the location of features.
- Observe and describe daily weather patterns.
- Begin to locate the four capital cities of the UK.
- Explain what the weather is like during each season in the UK.
- Suggest appropriate clothing and activities for each season.

- Designing in 3 dimensions
- Cut, form, tear, join and shape a range of materials to make an object they have designed.

Choose a teen number (13-19). Create a poster to show all of the number bonds to create that number.

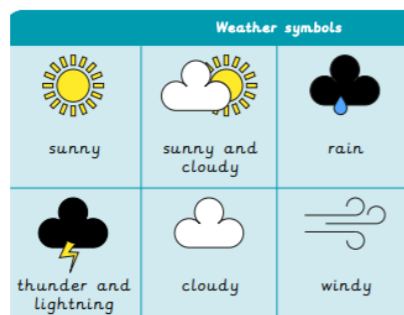
English:

Design a poster to remind people when they should wash their hands and why it is important.














