# WHAT THE NEW RULES MEAN FOR ME

Holden Clough Prin School I'm a single parent of one child and we want to go on holiday for a week.

Your holiday will not be authorised and you must talk to the school before you book anything.

Because your child will miss 5 school days you will be given a penalty notice fine.

The fine is £160 but if you pay it in 21 days it will be reduced to £80.

#### FOR EVERY CHILD A PENALTY IS GIVEN



Reduced to £320 if paid in 21 days

#### **IRREGULAR ATTENDANCE**



If your child is absent for 10 or more sessions in 10 weeks and their absences are unauthorised, the school will consider prosecution.



## FOR A FAMILY OF TWO PARENTS



If in any period of not more than 3 years, your child has a 2nd and 3rd leave of absence or pattern of irregular attendance...



#### 2ND TIME

+£160

#### 2 parents and...

1 child - £320 2 children = £640 3 children = £960 4 children = £1280

No discount for early payment

#### **3RD TIME**

A penalty notice fine will not be given.

Your case will be taken to court.

A magistrate can fine each parent £2500 for each child.

1 parent & 4 children = £10,000 2 parents & 4 children = £20,000

## Understanding Types of Absence

The school day consists of 2 sessions AM and PM. Every absence from school has to be classified by the school (not by parents), as either **AUTHORISED** or **UNAUTHORISED**. This is why detailed information about the cause of any absence is required.

<u>Authorised absences</u> are mornings or afternoons away from school for a good reason such as illness, medical/dental appointments which **unavoidably** fall in school time, emergencies or other unavoidable causes. Wherever possible please provide appointments cards/letters, copies of prescriptions etc. Children are often able to come into school when they are on medication. Please see our **Managing Medicines Policy**.

**SICKNESS:** please do not be offended if the amount of time your child is absent from school due to illness is challenged. If absence due to illness exceeds 3 days, it will not be authorised without evidence being provided.

<u>Unauthorised absences</u> are those which the school does not consider reasonable and for which no 'leave' has been granted. This can lead to the Local Authority using sanctions and / or legal proceedings. The following are NOT acceptable reasons for absence:

- Parents/Carers keeping children off school unnecessarily, which includes birthdays, holidays, shopping, days out or looking after other children
- Any other absences in term time which have not been authorised by the Headteacher
- Absences which have never been properly explained.

All unreported absence will be recorded as unauthorised unless an explanation can be provided which is satisfactory to the Headteacher.

Any unreported absence is a cause for concern. In the event that we are unable to make contact with you, we may visit your home address in accordance with our safeguarding procedures.

Also, if we have reason to believe that your family have gone on holiday without informing the school, we are obliged to check the attendance of siblings in other schools and again visit your home address.



## Reporting Absence

If your child is absent from school please ensure you report their absence to the school office as soon as possible on the first day and each day thereafter detailing the reason for their absence.

There is a facility to report pupil absence via our switchboard 0161 330 5248.

Please do not use Class Dojo to report an absence.

Any unreported absences will be recorded as UNAUTHORISED until an acceptable reason for the absence is provided. We are only able to authorise 3 days leave due to illness without medical evidence.
